

All in all, it looks like winter 17/18 could be very similar to our previous winter. Many forecasts are calling for "about normal" across the country's upper mid-section with above normal temperatures in the south and east. As you may recall, two winters ago it was <u>much</u> warmer than normal and last winter was closer to normal, but still warmer than normal. While we may finally see "normal" temperatures and precipitation this winter in the upper mid-section, it will certainly feel a bit harsher given the past two winters.
