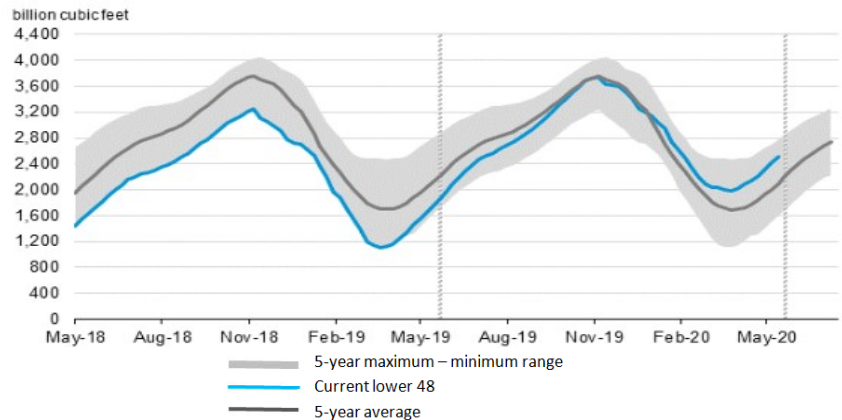

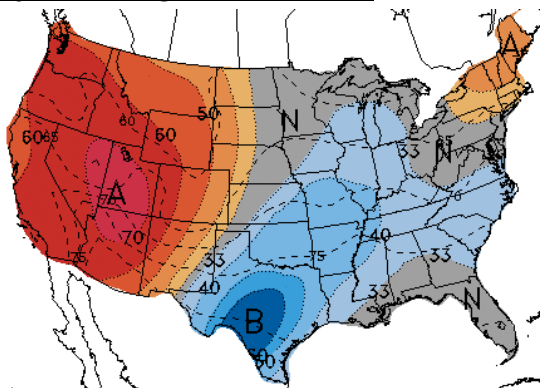

## Temperature Forecast

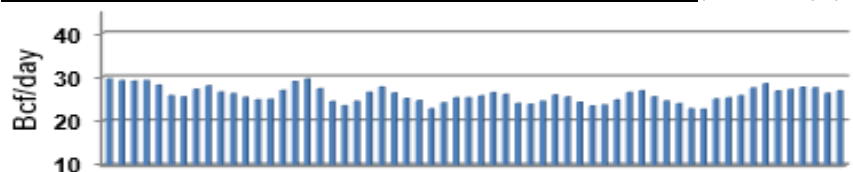
