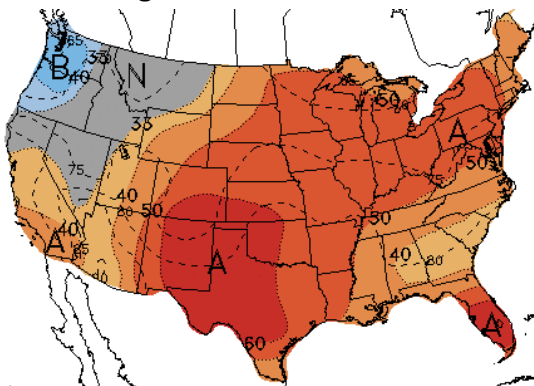
## Near-Month Natural Gas

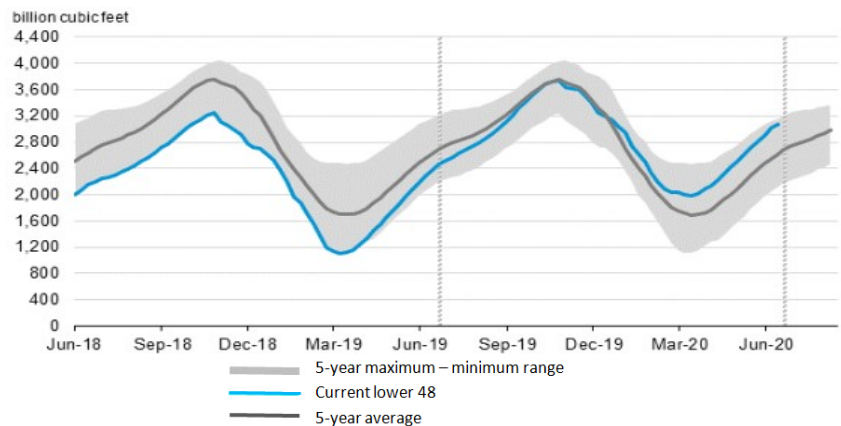

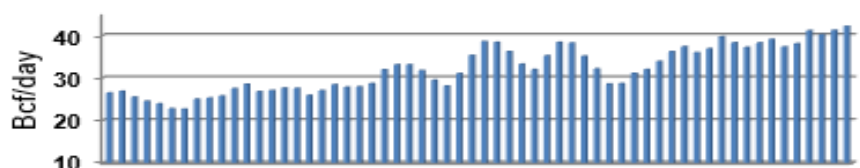
